

GENERAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR TRADITIONAL AND ONLINE CLASSES

A variety of GHCHS Summer School classes are available to students entering grades 10-12 who are currently enrolled at GHCHS and/or who are registered to enroll at GHCHS in the Fall of 2022. Student who are entering grade nine must enroll in Summer Transition Academy, however they may take accelerated math courses.

SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION WILL TAKE PLACE JUNE 9 THROUGH JUNE 12

- Grade 12: June 7, 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Grade 11: June 8, 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Grade 10: June 9, 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Grades 10-12: June 10, 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE FOR SUMMER SCHOOL:

- Students shall report to Highlander Hall to queue up. Once scanned in, counselors will meet with students starting at 8:00 a.m. by counselor and scan time.
- Class availability is determined by position in queue. Students should be prepared for long lines and a possible wait of two hours or more. Students are responsible for bringing water/snacks and reading materials. Summer school registration cannot be done in advance. Patience is appreciated.

LATE REGISTRATION:

- Students may register on June 13 from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. for any remaining classes with available space.
- Students absent on the first day of class will lose their summer school schedule and may re-register for classes with available space from 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on June 13. No registration priority will be given to these students.
- No students will be enrolled after June 14, 2022.
- GHCHS STUDENTS WHO TAKE SUMMER CLASSES AT OTHER INSTITUTIONS are required to obtain prior approval from their counselor before taking classes if they wish to apply the credits earned towards high school graduation. Students without prior authorization from their current school counselor will not earn high school credit. For more information, see your counselor.

COURSES ARE AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS IN GRADES 10-12 WHO:

- Have earned a mark of "D" or FAIL in a course taken
- Are in grade 11 or 12 AND failed courses required for graduation
- Need to take a class to earn a 2021 diploma
- Need bilingual/ELL instruction for English/Math proficiency
- Need a prerequisite for a Fall 2022 class
- Need to take a class for Fall 2022 schedule flexibility

COURSES ARE TENTATIVE AND MAY BE CLOSED OR ADDED WITHOUT NOTICE

- All classes except VAPA electives, PE, and accelerated math classes are credit recovery. Traditional AB\* courses are four-hour block classes.

DAILY IN SEAT ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED IN ALL CLASSES - TRADITIONAL AND ONLINE

Block 1 (Periods 1 and 2) 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.	Block 2 (Periods 3 and 4) 10:20 a.m. to 12:20 p.m.	Block 3 (Periods 5 and 6) 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
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- The last day to drop a class with a NO MARK is Friday, June 17. Students who drop a class after June 17 will receive a FAIL in the class.
- Students who *exceed* the listed hours of absences will receive a FAIL. Students will NOT be excused for extended absences, school activities, or vacations.
- Once a student completes an online course, attendance is no longer required

Four-Hour, Six Week Class TWELVE (12) hours of absences	Two-Hour, Six Week Class SIX (6) hours of absences
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- Students who are tardy will receive one hour of detention for each tardy.
- There is NO SCHOOL on MONDAY, July 4 due to the Fourth of July holiday.**
- All students must be present the last day of Summer School for the FINAL EXAM. Absent students will earn a zero on the final exam unless the absence is due to a verifiable family emergency or illness with doctor's note. Once documentation is received and verified, an *Incomplete* may be issued.
